### **Safety Protocols**

#### **⊮** Parking Lot Safety

Parents and Guardians Do NOT PARK in the middle of the drop off loop as this is a safety concern.

The drop–off zone cannot be used for parking, even if the driveway roundabout is empty. It is the designated fire route for the school/childcare.

Please, drive with caution, obey all traffic signals and allow the children and pedestrians to have the right of way. The safety and well-being of our children and staff continues to be a priority.

#### **ℜ School Barrier Gate**

Effective Monday Sept 19th, the barrier gate will be closed by 8:45am. Families: you will need to drop off your children to their designate program between 7:30am to 8:45am.

#### ℜ Drop off and Pick up
